Transfer from Vanuatu International Airport to Hotel

Port Vila is located approximately 5 KMs (10 minutes) away from Bauerfield International Airport.

- The host will provide airport transfers, please notify Mr John Jack on your arrival and departure times.
- Alternatively, taxi and bus services are available. The approximate taxi fare from the airport to the city centre is 2,000 VT (USD 21). The approximate bus fare is 150VT (USD 2) per person.

Visa and Immigration Requirements

All visitors to Vanuatu must have a valid passport for at least six (6) months beyond their intended length of stay in Vanuatu and a ticket for return or onward travel to another country which he/she is authorized to enter. Most Pacific Island countries are exempt from requiring a visa to enter Vanuatu.

Please check with your travel agents the appropriate visas and documentation necessary for your entry into Vanuatu.

Insurance

We request you to make your own necessary arrangements for travel insurance and medical coverage before travel.

Departure Tax

The Departure Tax from the International Airport is VT 2,500 per person (over 12 years) and is included in airfares. A separate domestic departure fee of VT 200 applies for departures from specific domestic terminals and is not included in fares, but paid separately.

Electricity

Electricity voltage is 230/240 volts with pin configuration similar to Australia and New Zealand. You are advised to take along your universal adaptor if you are from any other country with dissimilar pin configuration and voltages.

Currency

The local currency is Vatu (VT). Exchange rates vary around USD 1.00 = VUV 95.50. You can check the exchange rate at an Online Currency Converter on www.xe.com

Banks operating in Vanuatu include: ANZ, Westpac, National Bank, Pacific Bank. Foreign cash, traveller's cheques and credit cards are widely accepted in Port Vila.

Time

Local time in Vanuatu is UTC +11 hours

Climate

Vanuatu's climate is tropical all year round, with two distinct seasons – the cooler/drier season running from May to October and the wetter/hotter season from November to April. Average daily temperature is 29 degrees Celsius. Light weight clothing plus a sweater is usually sufficient, year round.
