Visa and Immigration Requirements:

• All visitors to American Samoa require a valid passport, return ticket or onward ticket and sufficient funds to support your stay.





- US Citizens and US Nationals do not require a visa and may enter and leave freely. Australia, New Zealand and citizens of the United Kingdom upon entering American Samoa are issued with a 30 day permit under the US Visa Waiver Program.
- All other international passport holders intending to visit American Samoa for business or holiday are required to apply for an entry visa.

Airport Tax:

No departure or arrival taxes for American Samoa.

Currency:

The United States Dollar is the currency of American Samoa. Major foreign currencies can be exchanged at the local banks & foreign exchange outlets.

Time:

American Samoa time is 11 hours behind Greenwich Mean Time (GMT -11)

Electricity:

110 volts using American power points.

Climate:

American Samoa has a tropical climate all year round with two distinct seasons, the wet

and dry season. The wet season is usually between December and March and the dry season from April through September with the average daily temperature around 83 degrees Fahrenheit all year round.





General Information about the city of the venue:

The Territory of American Samoa has a total land area of 76 square miles made up of five volcanic islands (Tutuila, Aunu'u, Ofu, Olosega and Ta'u) and two atolls (Rose and Swains). Including our marine waters and 200 mile exclusive economic zone, the Territory's total area is 117,500 square miles, about the size of the State of Oregon or New Zealand.

American Samoa is a tropical paradise and the climate averages 82 – 83 degrees Fahrenheit all year around and the ocean waters that surround our islands averaging 82 – 86 degrees Fahrenheit. With 90% of our islands covered in untouched tropical rainforest our flora and fauna is very unique.

Dress

Dress standard – Island casual - Ties discouraged.

Local Buses

The buses operate throughout the day with services ending around 5.00pm Monday to Friday. On Saturday bus services are heavily reduced and on Sundays only a handful of buses operate.

Communication Details:

The country dialing code to call American Samoa is (+1 684). To make an overseas call from American Samoa to the US dial (1), area code, then the phone number and dial (011), area code and the phone number if calling any other country. BlueSky Communications and American Samoa Telecommunications Authority sell overseas calling cards. Rental phones are also available from Blue Sky Communications. AT&T customers may roam with Bluesky Communications.
